Omaha, Neb – The Omaha Symphony and Film Streams have partnered to present the life and work of Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart through two distinct, but complementary, mediums: film and live orchestral music. In doing so, both organizations hope to educate and inspire community members through the power of art. The collaborative presentation of *Amadeus* is part of Film Streams' Community Development Program, which encourages partnerships with other nonprofits and community groups on film-related events that speak to their missions and programming

Film Streams will screen the Oscar-winning film *Amadeus* April 24-30 at the Ruth Sokolof Theater. To kick off the screening, Omaha Symphony music director Thomas Wilkins will introduce the film and lead an interactive Q & A forum on opening night. *Amadeus* is the perfect introduction to the Omaha Symphony's Mozart and Salieri concert on May 9, which will feature some of Mozart's most popular compositions. We hope that the visual storytelling of the film will help people find greater meaning in the music they hear at the performance.
