Mahler's mega-work is an expressive and expansive tour de force that demands enormous orchestral force. That includes unique instruments, such as a tenor horn, mandolin, guitar, two harps, and even cowbells! The program also features Prokofiev's March in B-flat Major and Vaughan Williams's Fantasia on a Theme by Thomas Tallis.
