## Relive the 1980s classic in Omaha Symphony's *Back to the Future* in Concert

*Film will be screened in its entirety as the orchestra plays Alan Silvestri's score live*

OMAHA, Neb., Feb. 13, 2018- Great Scott! Join the Omaha Symphony in an adventure more than 30 years in the making with *Back to the Future in Concert*, Saturday, February 24, 7:30 p.m., at the Holland Performing Arts Center.

Relive the comic adventure of Marty McFly as he goes back in time in Doc Brown's DeLorean. Alan Silvestri's score will be played live while the film is screened in its entirety. This version of the film contains 20 minutes of additional music added by Silvestri, exclusive to the symphony concert experience. Principal Pops Conductor Ernest Richardson will conduct.

Directed by Robert Zemeckis and produced by Steven Spielberg, *Back to the Future* stars Michael J. Fox as teenager Marty McFly, who is accidentally sent back to 1955 from 1985 in Doc Brown's (Christopher Lloyd) DeLorean. There, Marty meets his teenage future parents and unwittingly becomes his mother's romantic interest. Doc must help Marty make his parents fall in love, thus repairing history, and make it back to 1985. *Back to the Future* became the highest grossing film of 1985, and spawned two sequels. In 2008, it was designated the 10th best film in the science fiction genre by the American Film Institute.

An authentic DeLorean will be available in the Holland Center's valet parking area for patrons to take photos to commemorate their experience at the concert.

Student Rush tickets are available one hour prior to the concert. Any student with a valid student ID may purchase up to two Student Rush tickets for \$10 each.
