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The Beach Boys with the Omaha Symphony to appear on Australian TV news program *Sunday Night will film The Beach Boys in Omaha this weekend*

OMAHA, Neb., May 31, 2018- If you're Down Under in June, you might catch a glimpse of the Omaha Symphony on Channel Seven's *Sunday Night* news program, in a segment featuring The Beach Boys.

Staats said The Beach Boys are "huge" in Australia and considered a "heritage artist."

Sunday Night is an Australian news and current affairs program which features a mix of feature stories, investigative reports, forums, and interviews. Staats compared it to *60 Minutes*.

Principal Pops Conductor Ernest Richardson will lead the Beach Boys with the Omaha Symphony in three performances this weekend, Friday and Saturday, June 1 & 2, 7:30 p.m., and Sunday, June 3, at 2 p.m. The concert will include hits like "Good Vibrations," "California Girls," "I Get Around," "Surfin' USA," "Little Deuce Coupe," "Kokomo," "God Only Knows," "Little Surfer Girl," "Help Me, Rhonda," and many more.
