Concerts For Youth

- ★ During the 2022-2023 school year, 5,500 students registered for the concert.
- ★ This is the 21st year we have had a recorder concert in Omaha!

Learning Targets for This Experience:

- ★ Teach students fundamental music concepts through listening and performing.
- ★ Foster existing and new relationships between symphony orchestras and the schools they serve.
- ★ Expose students to the symphony orchestra and concert hall in their community.

What is new this year?

- ★ This year's program is unique to the Omaha Symphony.
- ★ We are incorporating more body percussion into the play along slides to add a new participatory layer to the concert.

Materials

- ★ The Omaha Symphony will provide recorders for those schools indicating a supply support request.
- ★ Recorders can be property of the school or the student. Check with your district administration to determine who owns the recorders.



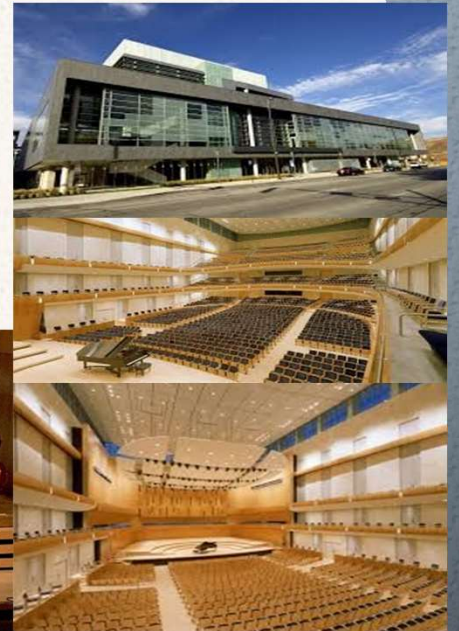

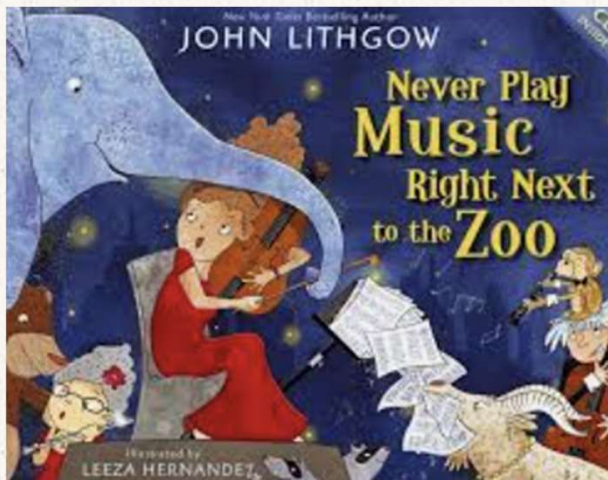
